

15,500 total food boxes distributed

700 food boxes distributed monthly

2,000 volunteers packed food boxes

Jump Start Programs Close Academic Gaps

Because of your support ...



The students had amazing success in 2022

- 60% of parents reported the highest level of improvement in their children's learning skills (5 on a scale of 1-5)
- 8th Graders improved their language and math grades from 69% and 64% to 93% and 92%
- 25% increase in number of participating children (108 last year to 136 this year)
- **84%** of parents give the teachers assigned to their children the highest rating (5 on a scale of 1-5)

In 2023, we plan to increase the number of participants in Jump Start, reaching more adolescents in need of academic and emotional support.

Building Connections & Impacting Lives

2022 at our Parent-Child Centers:

- 60 families, including 80 children, participated in activities at the Parent-Child Center monthly
- 1670 total visits to the Center
- 1070 hours of therapy
- 220 different families participated throughout the year in 11 separate groups
- 2 Purim events and 1 end-of-year celebration
- New "mother to mother" project initiated for postpartum mothers





2020 - 2022 - 2025


Number of Program

Beit Shemesh Educational Center Class of 2022

We are extremely proud to share our students' achievements:



The entire twelfth-grade class graduated, including all students in our specialized tracks for Ethiopian-Israeli and Haredi students.



Matriculation rate far exceeded the national average in all three tracks: Haredi, Ethiopian-Israeli, and mainstream.



Graduates volunteered in Israel's National Service Program for National Police and Magen David first responders



28% of graduates continued their academic studies in rabbinic programs.



45% of graduates have enlisted in the IDF, including elite army units, or in pre-military academies.



Other graduates enrolled in electrical engineering degree programs and in courses to complete subject requirements not yet fulfilled.



Drama department leads the nation with 3 first-place finishes in short film contest with semi-autobiographical films depicting the actual challenges they faced growing up in unstable homes, and how success can be achieved with perseverance and faith. (Recent award winning film, in Hebrew).
